Dirty, tattered clothes, loose pants and a tie-up shirt (ghillie) shirt. His shoes have holes and he is covered in dirt and feathers from dealing with animals all day long.

The Damsel Genevieve has lived in the palace for her whole life. The queen took her in when she was just a baby after the unfortunate death of her courtier mother. The Saxons cared for her until the queen's suspicious death. One month ago Genevieve was married to the king's jousting knight, Sir Arthur Williams.

A beautiful, colourful dress adorned with lace and velvet, hair tied back.

# SAMUEL GARRIDY

Long, flowing brown robes and a large hat adorned with gray feathers.

## PRINCE LEONARD WEARS:

Regal robes, a crown and a sword on his hip holster.

Knight Sir Arthur Williams has recently received the highest honour a knight can receive from a king. He was called back to the castle amidst his first battle to be a jousting knight full time, by personal request of King Saxon. He had not been home but a few months when the king offered him the hand of the damsel Genevieve, and the two were married just over one month ago.

# SIR ARTHUR WILLIAMS

## WEARS:

A regal tie-up (ghillie) shirt and tights with a long robe. He carries a mace and a sword on his hip holster.
